SPECIAL NOTICE TO ASSESSORS.

I would respectfully call the attention of Assessors to the following portion of the laws of 1854, Section 41.

They shall also make, under proper headings, a tabular statement showing the footing of the several columns upon each page. Assessors are especially requested to return their books to this office on or before the first Monday in July. It is absolutely necessary for the Auditor to have them as early as possible, in order to prepare them for the Board of Equalization.
