According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the said ... for the year 1949, as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Personal Property, and to make such change in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, ... is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his personal property...

Sec. 273.26. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property. Personal Property shall be listed and assessed as follows: 1. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof...

Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land owned or controlled by the railroad...

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline companies. Personal property of pipeline companies, including gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.36. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies, situated in cities and villages...

Sec. 273.37. Personal property of electric light and power companies in other than personal property. Personal property of electric light and power companies, situated in other than personal property...

Sec. 273.44. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the time of the decedent's death...

Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the time of the assignment or receivership...

Sec. 273.47. Property removed from one county, town, or district. Personal property removed from one county, town, or district shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district to which it is removed...

Sec. 273.02. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who makes a false statement regarding taxes, or who makes a false statement regarding the value of property, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100...

Sec. 273.03. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. New classification. All property shall be classified for taxation as follows: Class 1. Real estate...

Class 1a. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces that are utilized in the form produced and are not further refined...

Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including stoves, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles...

Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a", and class three "d", stocks of merchandise of all sorts...

Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class four "a", and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Class 5. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class five "a", and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Class 6. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces that are utilized in the form produced and are not further refined...

Class 7. All household goods and furniture, including stoves, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles...

Class 8. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a", and class three "d", stocks of merchandise of all sorts...

Class 9. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class nine "a", and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Class 10. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class ten "a", and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Class 11. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces that are utilized in the form produced and are not further refined...

Class 12. All household goods and furniture, including stoves, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles...

Class 13. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a", and class three "d", stocks of merchandise of all sorts...

Class 14. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class fourteen "a", and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Class 15. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class fifteen "a", and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Class 16. All direct products of the blast and open hearth furnaces that are utilized in the form produced and are not further refined...

Class 17. All household goods and furniture, including stoves, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles...

Class 18. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a", and class three "d", stocks of merchandise of all sorts...

Class 19. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class nineteen "a", and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Class 20. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class twenty "a", and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03, as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property. The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county-seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1949 assessment by G. HOWARD SPAETH, Commissioner of Taxation.

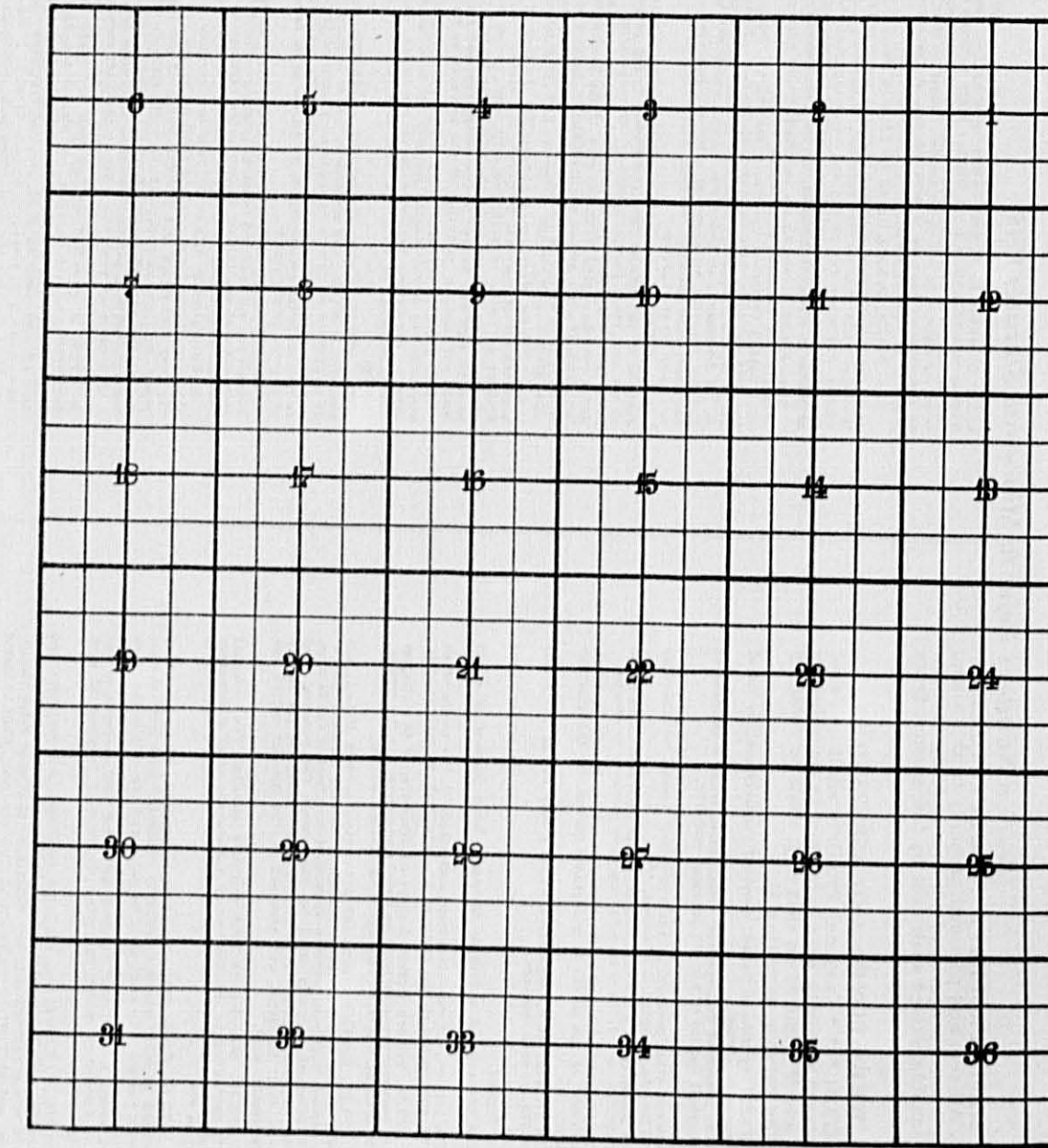
