Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, *** is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list separately, and in the name of his principal, all moneys and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney, ***.

Sec. 273.03. Certain personal property; where listed. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, and all personal property used by the owner for personally domestic purposes, or for the furnishing or equipment of the family, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.04. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where the business is conducted ***.

Sec. 273.05. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside therein, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the farm is situated. If the farm is situated in several towns or districts it shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such farm is located.

Sec. 273.06. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by such company, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.
