Grenville, Assessor of the Vil. of Cass Lake According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the said containing a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment of May 1, 1916, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Personal Property, and to make such changes in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1915)

Sec. 273.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, shall be taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED Sec. 273.01. * * * Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person owning, or having possession of, or control of, any real or personal property, being a resident of this state, shall list the same on or before May 1, 1916, and on or before the same date in every subsequent year. All moneys and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney, or by any person acting by his grant, or by the person having such property in charge, shall be listed by the grantor, or by the person having such property in charge.

2. The property of a decedent or of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator thereof, or by the person having such property in charge, shall be listed by such receiver.

3. The property of a body, politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.

4. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

5. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, as merchandise.

Sec. 273.26. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, all personal property shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property; where listed. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel of members of the family, and other articles of personal use, and all articles of personal use, domestic purposes, or for the furnishing or equipment of the family residence, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the owner thereof resides.

Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on.

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of real or personal property is a non-resident, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the farm is situated. If the farm is situated in another county, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the owner resides.

Sec. 273.32. Electric, etc., on railroad. All electric light and power companies, with the machinery and fixtures thereof, situated upon any city or village, or in any other place, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually located.

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline companies. Personal property of pipeline companies, with the machinery and fixtures thereof, situated upon any city or village, or in any other place, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually located.

Sec. 273.34. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies, with the machinery and fixtures thereof, situated upon any city or village, or in any other place, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually located.

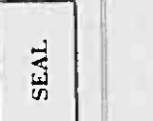
