In your 1931 assessment book you have listed under the heading " Amount of Assessed Value Deducted by reason of fire, flood or otherwise ", on Lot 21, Blk. 7, Orig. Plat, belonging to A. N. Kriebs, the amount of \$500.00. I presume you meant this for full and true value instead of assessed value. The full and true value of the improvements on this lot as equalized for the year 1930, was \$ 616.00. As you only report a deduction of \$500.00, am wondering if some part of the improvements are left and should be assessed for 1931?

Also, in your 1931 returns, you have listed an added building to Mrs. M. J. Shaffer on Lot 10, Blk. 1. Lot 10 is in the name of Kendall but Mrs. Shaffer owns Lots 11, 12 and 13, Blk. 1. Perhaps Mrs. Shaffer has bought Lot 10 on contract from Kendall but the tax list still shows Lot 10 to be in the name of Kendall. Am wondering if you have the correct description.
