According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the said
containing a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment of May 1, 1948, so far
as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Personal Property,
and to make such change in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof to me
as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)
Sec. 273.01. PERSONAL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, shall be listed and assessed in accordance with the laws and provisions relating to taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED
Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following:
1. The property of a sole proprietor shall be listed by the owner or, if he is a minor, by his guardian or the person having such property in charge.

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside in the state, the assessor may, if he is satisfied that the farm is situated in the several towns or districts, it shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such owner is located.

Sec. 273.37. Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the city or town in which the principal place of business of such company is located.

Sec. 273.44. Estates of decedents. The personal property of decedents shall be listed and assessed at the time of their death.

Sec. 273.46. Assignments and receivers. Personal property in the hands of assignees and receivers shall be listed and assessed at the time of the filing of their reports.

Sec. 273.13. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax shall be classified as follows:
Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined.

Subdivision 2. Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined shall constitute class one and shall be valued and assessed at fifty per cent of the market value thereof at the time it is mined or but at the rate aforesaid, from the date in which it is located.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel, and other articles of personal use, shall be valued and assessed at 75 per cent of the fair market value thereof.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided by class three "a," and class three "b," stocks of merchandise of all sorts together with the turntable-mounted articles, all tools, implements and machinery, whether fixtures or otherwise, except as provided by class three "c," shall be valued and assessed at 75 per cent of the fair market value thereof.

Subdivision 5. Class 3a. All agricultural products in the hands of the producer shall constitute class three "a," and shall be valued and assessed at 10 per cent of full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 6. Class 3b. Livestock, poultry, all horses, mules, and geldings, and machinery used by the owner, shall be valued and assessed at 75 per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Subdivision 9. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall constitute class four and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 270.07. The Commissioner of Taxation shall prescribe the form of all blanks and books required under this chapter.
Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.03 as amended. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known; and, if unknown, so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property.

The assessors and at least one member of each local board of review shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the commissioner of taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor and board of review member attending such meetings shall receive as compensation for such service the sum of \$6.00 per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending such meeting, and mileage at the rate of five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.

The forms in this book are prescribed for the 1949 assessment by G. HOWARD SPAETH, Commissioner of Taxation.

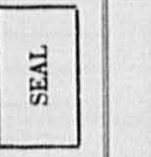
