According to the requirements of law herewith deliver to you the Redd and Personal Property Assessment Books for the year 1946, containing a list of all Real Estate subject to taxation, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source and I hereby direct you to assess all property and make return thereof to me as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota prescribing the duties of the assessor.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

## Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

### (Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

**Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION.** All real and personal property in this state and all personal property of persons residing therein, \*\*\* is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

**WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED**  
**Sec. 273.01. \*** Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

**Sec. 273.22. BY WHOM LISTED.** Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:

1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state shall list all of his personal property, including all moneys and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney. \*\*\*

2. He shall list the property of a minor, child or insane person when he is the property of a partner, child or insane person when he is the trustee of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

3. He shall list the property of a corporation, partnership, or receiver, by such receiver.

4. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.

5. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

6. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, as merchandise.

**Sec. 273.26. WHERE LISTED.** Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent or trustee resides.

**Sec. 273.27. CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY; WHERE LISTED.** All personal property, including real estate, machinery, tools, implements, sailing machines, wearing apparel of members of the family, and all personal property used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, shall be listed in the town or district where the residence, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is usually kept.

**Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers.** The personal property of a merchant or manufacturer, including the stock in trade, shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on \*\*\*.

**Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident.** When the owner of livestock or other personal property in a town or district is not resident thereon, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such firm or person is located. It shall be listed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such firm or person is located. \*\*\*

**Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad.** All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures thereon, situated upon the land of any railroad company which are not in good faith owned, leased, or otherwise used by the railroad company, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

**Sec. 273.33. Pipeline companies.** Personal property of pipeline companies, including gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products \*\*\* shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

**Sec. 273.36. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages.** Personal property of electric light and power companies, including machinery, tools, implements, and fixtures, shall be listed and assessed in the city or borough in which the same is usually kept.

**Sec. 273.37. Personal property of electric light and power companies in towns and villages.** Personal property of electric light and power companies, including machinery, tools, implements, and fixtures, shall be listed and assessed in the town or village in which the same is usually kept.

**Sec. 273.38. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages.** Personal property of electric light and power companies, including machinery, tools, implements, and fixtures, shall be listed and assessed in the city or borough in which the same is usually kept.

**Sec. 273.46. Assignees and receivers.** Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver, including machinery, tools, implements, and fixtures, shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.

**Sec. 273.47. Property moved between May and July.** The owner of personal property removing from one county, town, or district to another, shall list the same in the county, town, or district to which he removes the same.

**Sec. 273.48. Movable personal property.** Movable personal property, including machinery, tools, implements, and fixtures, shall be listed in the county, town, or district in which it is usually kept. \*\*\*

Section 273.03, Minnesota Statutes 1945. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property. \*\*\*

The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. \*\*\*
