According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the year 1949, containing a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment of May 1, 1948, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Personal Property, and to make such change in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. Personal property shall be listed 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all his personal property.

Sec. 273.03. Where listed. Except as otherwise in this chapter provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the town, or district where owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 273.04. Personal property of non-resident. When the owner of real or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside in the town, or district, where the farm is situated in several towns or districts, it shall be listed and assessed in the town, or district, in which the principal place of business of such farm is located.

Sec. 273.05. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery and fixtures therein, situated upon the land and surrounded completely by water, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.06. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.07. Personal property of electric light and power companies in rural areas. Personal property of electric light and power companies in rural areas shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.08. Personal property of manufacturing and other businesses. Personal property of manufacturing and other businesses shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.09. Personal property of agricultural producers. Personal property of agricultural producers shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.10. Personal property of stock raisers. Personal property of stock raisers shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.11. Personal property of other persons. Personal property of other persons shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.12. Personal property of partnerships. Personal property of partnerships shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.13. Personal property of corporations. Personal property of corporations shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.14. Personal property of trusts. Personal property of trusts shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.15. Personal property of minors. Personal property of minors shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.16. Personal property of guardians. Personal property of guardians shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.17. Personal property of decedents. Personal property of decedents shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.18. Personal property of estates. Personal property of estates shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.19. Personal property of executors. Personal property of executors shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.20. Personal property of administrators. Personal property of administrators shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.21. Personal property of receivers. Personal property of receivers shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.22. Personal property of partners. Personal property of partners shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.23. Personal property of joint tenants. Personal property of joint tenants shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.24. Personal property of tenants in common. Personal property of tenants in common shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.25. Personal property of life tenants. Personal property of life tenants shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.26. Personal property of remaindermen. Personal property of remaindermen shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.27. Personal property of persons claiming under a will. Personal property of persons claiming under a will shall be listed and assessed as real property in the town or district where situated.
