Section 1986. Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks for the county, or and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book complete lists of all real estate, and the lots or parts of lots, or blocks included in each description of personal property. The list of real property becoming subject to assessment and taxation every odd numbered year may be appended to the personal property assessment book. The assessment books and blanks shall be in readiness for delivery to the assessors or before the third Monday in APRIL of each year. The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Minnesota Tax Commission for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive as compensation the sum of five dollars per day for each day necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat at the rate of five cents for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat to be computed by the usually traveled route and paid out of the county treasury up to the warrant of the county auditor.
