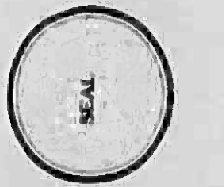

EXTRACTS FROM LAWS

(Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minn. Statutes 1937.)
Sec. 197. Property subject to taxation—All real and personal property in the state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, ... is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.
Sec. 198. All real property subject to taxation shall be assessed annually on the first day of May, and assessed with reference to its value on May 1 of that year.
Sec. 199. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the name of the principal, as merchant-towns or district where the owner, agent, or trustee resides.
Sec. 200. Where listed. Except as otherwise provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the owner, agent, or trustee resides.
Sec. 201. Personal property of electric light and power companies in cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies having their principal place of business in the state shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the principal place of business is located.
Sec. 202. Eminent domain. Personal property in the hands of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed where the guardian resides.
Sec. 203. Personal property of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing at the time of his death.
Sec. 204. Personal property of every other person. Personal property in the hands of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed at the place of listing before his appointment.
