Extracts from laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing in this state, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following:

1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his real and personal property in this state, and all other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney.

2. The property of a minor, child or insane person, shall be listed by his guardian, or of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust, by the trustee, or of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.

3. The property of a partnership whose assets are in the hands of a partner, shall be listed in the town or district where his business is carried on.

4. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.

5. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.

6. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, as merchant, broker, consignee, or otherwise.

7. The property of a partnership, when listed, shall be listed in the name of the partnership, and shall be listed in the name of the principal place of business of such firm.

Sec. 273.03. Minnesota Statutes 1941. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands and improvements in each assessment district, showing the names of the owners, if known, and, if unknown, so that the names of the owners can be ascertained by reference to the records of the county auditor. The assessment books and blanks shall be in readiness for delivery to the assessors on or before the third Monday in APRIL of each year.

The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. Each assessor attending such meetings shall receive compensation for such service the sum of four dollars per day for each day necessarily consumed in attending a meeting from the county seat, to be paid for five cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled in going from his home to and returning from the county seat, to be computed by the usually traveled route, and paid out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor.
