## Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1949, as amended)

Sec. 272.01. **PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAX.**—All real and personal property in this state, with the exception of all property exempt from taxation, shall be taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

**WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED**

Sec. 273.01. Personal Property shall be listed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following:

- Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his real property in the name of his principal, agent, or other personal property invested, leased, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney.
- The property of a minor, child, or insane person shall be listed by the trustee of the estate of a deceased person, by the executor or administrator.
- The property of a partnership whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, by such receiver.
- The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.
- The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.
- The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of his principal, as merchandise, provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where owner, agent or trustee resides.

Sec. 273.03. Certain personal property, where listed, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.04. Pipelines, Gas and Water Companies, Electric Light and Power Companies, and other public utilities, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the principal place of business of such company or corporation is located.

Sec. 273.05. Gas and Water Companies, Electric Light and Power Companies, and other public utilities, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the principal place of business of such company or corporation is located.

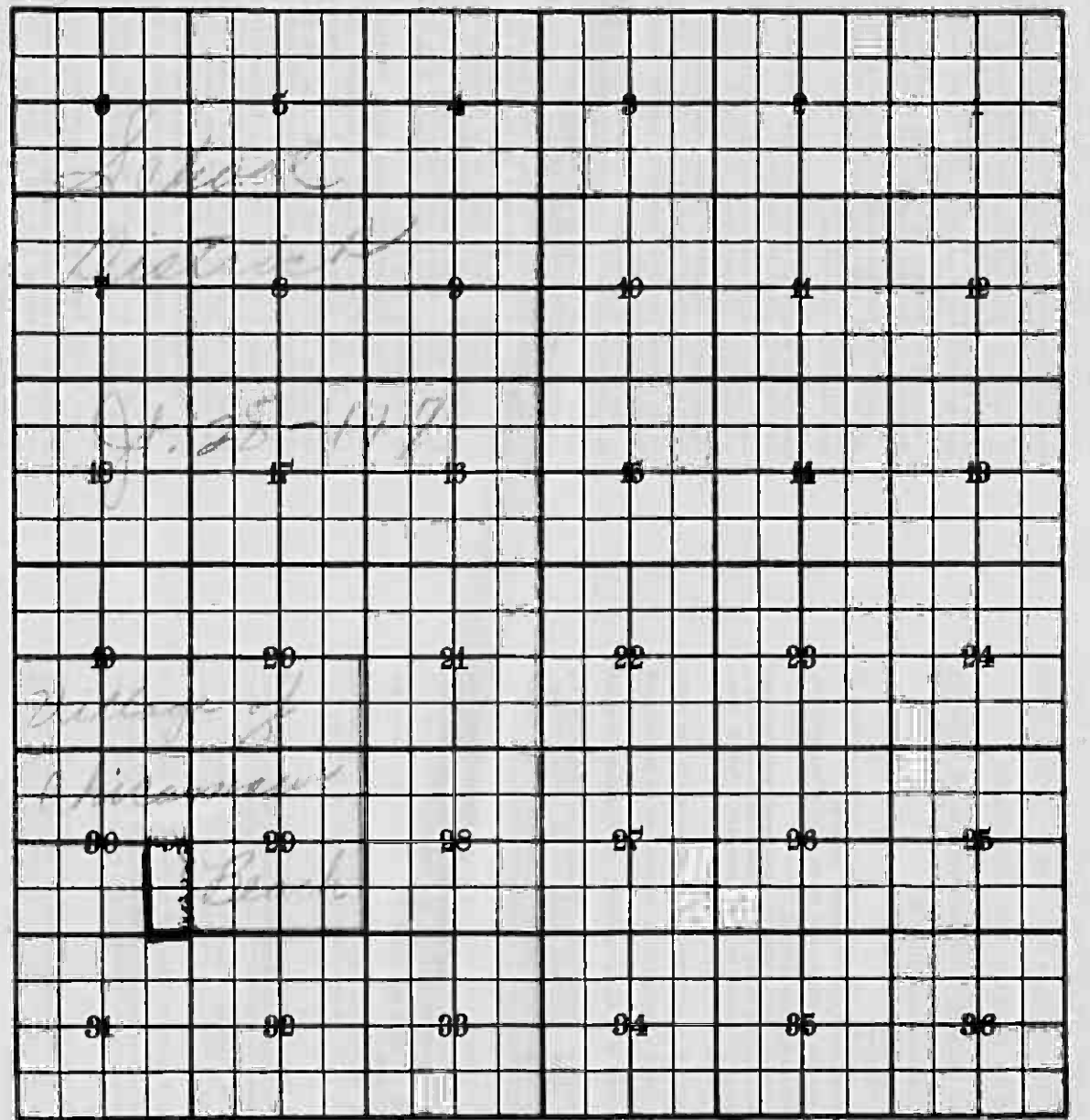
