A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1941 as Amended by Laws 1943)

Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, \* \* \* is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED AND ASSESSED ANNUALLY WITH REFERENCE TO ITS VALUE ON May 1, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all real estate, and in the name of his principal, all money and other personal property invested, loaned, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property; where listed. All household goods and furniture, including household goods and furniture, including automobiles, and all personal property used by the owner for personal and domestic purposes, or for the furnishing of equipment of the family residence, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same are usually kept. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.32. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer carried on \* \* \* listed in the town or district where the business is carried on. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.36. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property owned and used in the town or district, where the farm is situated. \* \* \* Provided, that if the farm is situated in several towns or districts, it shall be listed in the town or district in which the principal place of business of such farm is located. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.44. Estates of decedents. The personal property of the estate of a decedent person shall be listed and assessed at the place of such estate. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.55. Persons under Guardianship. The personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed where the guardian resides. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.56. Assignments and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of the business of the assignor or of the receiver. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.63. Minnesota Statutes 1941. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county for and to correspond with each assessment district. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.12. Classification of property—Subdivision 1. How classified. All real and personal property shall be classified and assessed according to the following: \* \* \*

Subdivision 2. Class 1. From ore whether mined or unmined shall constitute Class one and shall be valued as follows: \* \* \*

Sec. 273.16. Failure to obtain list. In case of doubt, in case of doubt a written agreement shall be made between the assessor and the owner, which shall be the true value thereof. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.20. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property, may enter any dwelling, barn, outhouse, or structure, and view the same and the property therein. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.25. False statements regarding taxes. Every person who makes a false statement or enters a written report which is intended to defraud the county, shall be guilty of a crime under this section. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.26. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor has any reason to doubt the accuracy of any return, he may examine such person under oath in regard to the amount of the assessment. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.30. Lists to be verified. Every assessor to the assessment, shall verify the list, and the list shall be verified by the assessor or places in different counties, by the Department of Taxation. \* \* \*

Sec. 273.35. Lists to be verified. Every assessor to the assessment, shall verify the list, and the list shall be verified by the assessor or places in different counties, by the Department of Taxation. \* \* \*

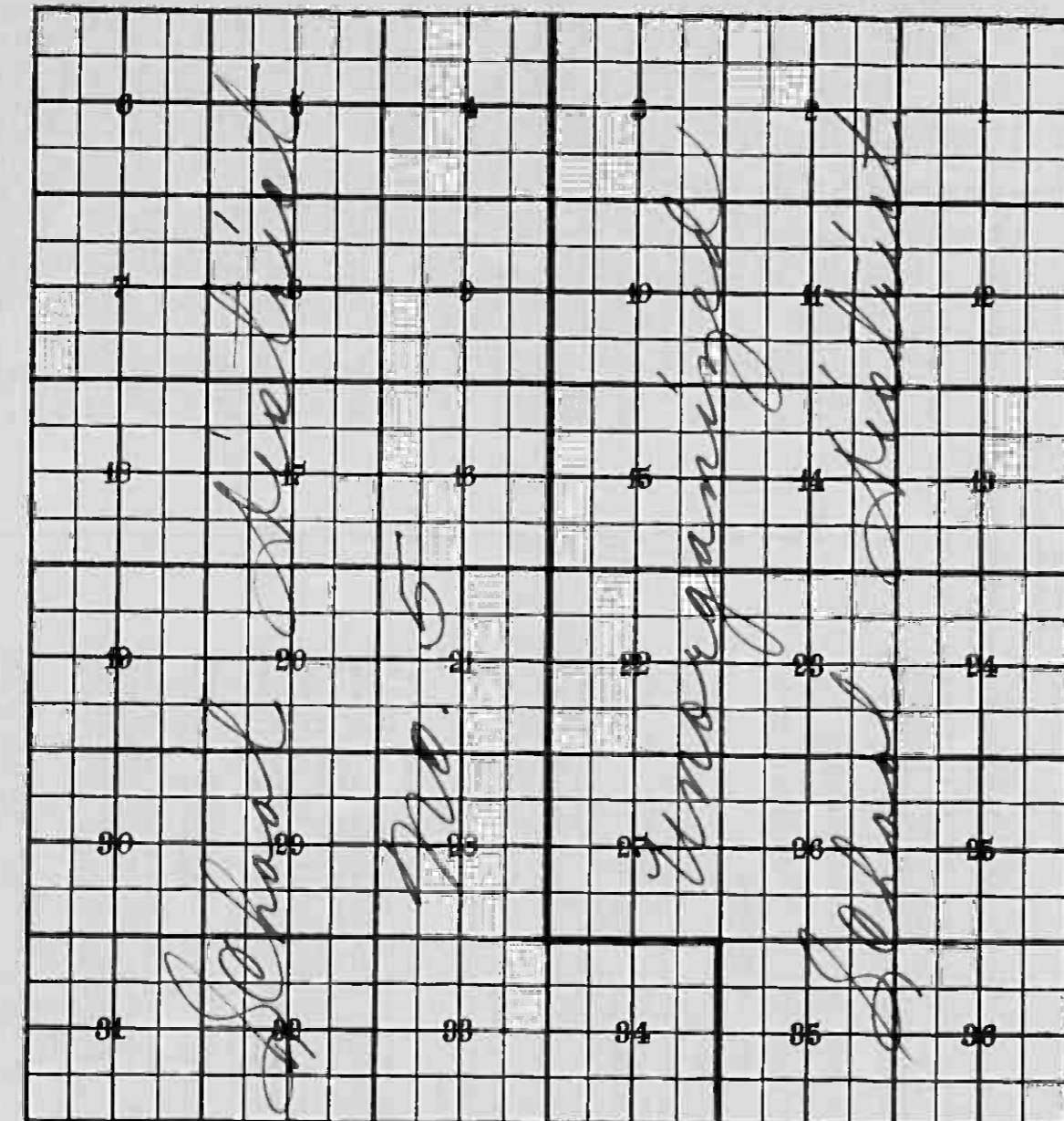
