## Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

- Sec. 272.01. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION.** All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, \*\*\* is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.
- WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED**
- Sec. 273.01 \*\*\*** Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1 of each year, if it is not so listed on that day or for the persons acquiring it.
- Sec. 273.02.** By whom listed. Personal Property shall be listed in the manner following:
1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his \*\*\* personal property.
  2. If he shall die separately, and in the name of his principal, he shall list the same separately, and the same shall be assessed and assessed in his name as agent or trustee under the will, or otherwise controlled by him as agent or attorney, \*\*\*.
  3. The property of a minor, child or insane person shall be listed by his guardian, or by the person having such property in charge.
  4. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust, shall be listed by the trustee, or the estate of a decedent person, by the executor or administrator.
  5. The property of a corporation whose assets are in the hands of a receiver, or of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or officer thereof.
  6. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.
  7. The property of a partnership, in the hands of an agent, by such agent in the name of the partnership.
  8. The property of a partnership, in the hands of a partner, shall be listed as if it were the property of the partnership, except as otherwise provided, personal property shall be listed and assessed in the name of the partner, agent or trustee resident in the county.
- Sec. 273.27.** Certain personal property, including: household goods, wearing apparel, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel of members of the family, automobiles, and other articles which are used for personal, domestic purposes, or for the furnishing or equipping of the family residence, shall be listed and assessed in the district where the same is actually kept.
- Sec. 273.28.** Personal property, including: stocks, bonds, securities, property pertaining to the business of a merchant or of a manufacturer, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where such property is kept.
- Sec. 273.30.** Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of livestock or other personal property connected with a farm does not reside in the town or district where such property is kept, the same shall be listed and assessed in the town or district in which the principal place of residence of such person or district in which the principal place of residence of such person is located.
- Sec. 273.32.** Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and workhouses, with the machinery and fixtures thereon, situated upon any railroad, shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where such property is kept.
- Sec. 273.33.** Pipeline companies. Personal property of pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting natural gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products \*\*\* shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.
- Sec. 273.36.** Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where such property is kept.
- Sec. 273.37.** Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed where situated.
- Sec. 273.40.** Personal property of electric light and power companies. Personal property of electric light and power companies shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where such property is kept.

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The county auditor shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. \*\*\*

Section 273.03, Minnesota Statutes 1945. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated, opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property. \*\*\*

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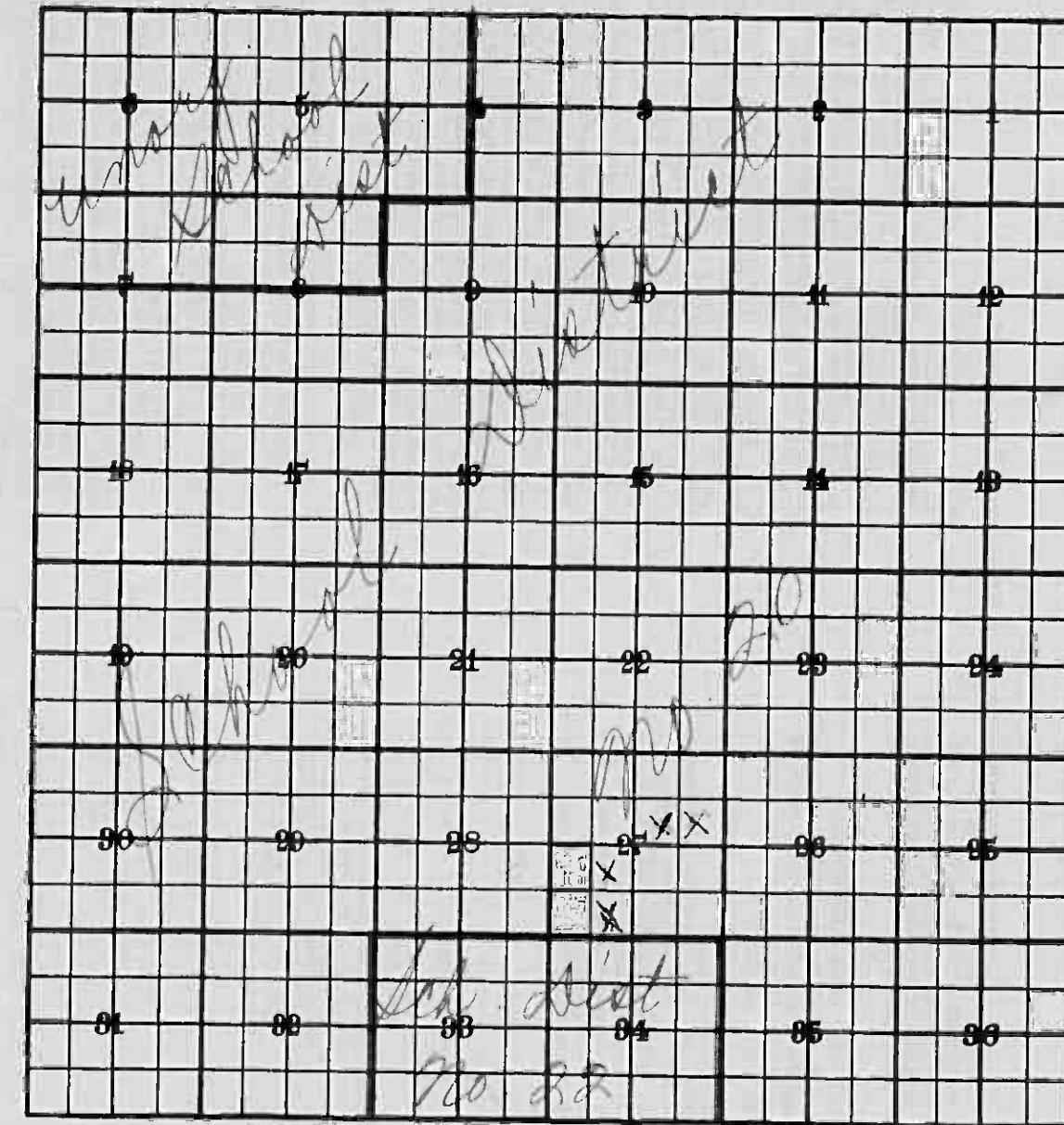
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For Convenience of Auditor in Showing Boundaries of School Districts
