Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property

(Section Numbers Refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927.)

Sec. 1974. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All Real and Personal Property in this State, and all Personal Property of persons residing therein, * * * is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED.

- Sec. 1984. * * * Personal Property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.
Sec. 1989. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:
1. This State shall be divided into townships, and the assessor of each township shall list and assess all personal property of the township on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.
2. The property of a farm or other personal property shall be listed by the owner, or by the person in charge of the property, or by the assessor or administrator of the estate of a deceased person, by the assessor of the township, or by the assessor of the township or of a receiver, by such receiver.
3. The property of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent or other thereof.
4. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.
5. The property of manufacturers and others in the hands of any railroad company, by the proper agent, by the assessor of the county, town, or district where the property is located.
6. The property of a partnership, by the partner or agent thereof.
7. The property of a partnership, by the partner or agent thereof.
8. The property of a partnership, by the partner or agent thereof.

- Sec. 2017. Property moved between May and July. The owner of any personal property moved between May 1 and July 1, shall be assessed in this State on the basis of its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.
Sec. 2018. Where listed in case of death. In case of death of any person, his personal property shall be listed and assessed in this State on the basis of its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.
Sec. 2019. Where listed in case of divorce. In case of divorce, the personal property of the parties shall be listed and assessed in this State on the basis of its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it.
Sec. 2020. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor of a township is satisfied that any person liable to be assessed has failed to list and assess his property, he may examine such person under oath and compute list therefor. He may examine such person at the place for listing and assessing, and if between different townships, at the place for listing and assessing in either case shall be determined by the assessor.
Sec. 2021. Lists to be verified. Every person required to list and assess his property shall make out and deliver to the assessor a statement of his personal property, which shall be examined and verified by him on May 1 of the current year. The assessor shall return to the person a copy of the statement so verified, and shall also return to the person a copy of the statement so verified, and shall also return to the person a copy of the statement so verified.
Sec. 2022. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a statement of personal property, the assessor shall ascertain the amount of such property as he believes to be the true value thereof, and shall assess the same accordingly.
Sec. 2023. Assessor may enter dwellings, etc. Any officer authorized by law to assess property for taxation may, when necessary, enter any dwelling, building, or structure, and view the same and the contents thereof, and make such list and assessment as he may deem proper.
Sec. 2024. False statement regarding taxes. No person who in making any statement, oral or written, for the purpose of evading any tax or assessment, or who shall be guilty of any such offense, shall be liable to a civil penalty which he knows to be false, shall be liable to a civil penalty.

CHAPTER 58

- Section 1. That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1060, be amended so as to read as follows:
"Class 3b. All unimproved real estate, except as provided by class one (1) hereof and which is used for the purposes of a homestead at twenty (20) per cent of the true and full value thereof, provided in excess of said amount in the hands of the owner, shall be assessed by class three (3) hereof. Provided, further, that the estate used for the purpose of a homestead shall be exempt from and true value shall remain subject to said class 3b, \$100,000 full value for the discharge of any and all state indebtedness and taxes and charges at the time of the passage of this act.
"Class 3c. All which is used for the purposes provided by class one (1) hereof and which shall be valued and assessed at twenty (20) per cent of the true and full value thereof, and which is used for the purposes of a homestead at twenty (20) per cent of the true and full value thereof, provided in excess of said amount in the hands of the owner, shall be assessed by class four (4) hereof. Provided, further, that the estate used for the purposes of a homestead shall be exempt from and true value shall remain subject to said class 3c, \$100,000 full value for the discharge of any and all state indebtedness and taxes and charges at the time of the passage of this act.
"Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof."
Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1927.
Approved July 29, 1927.

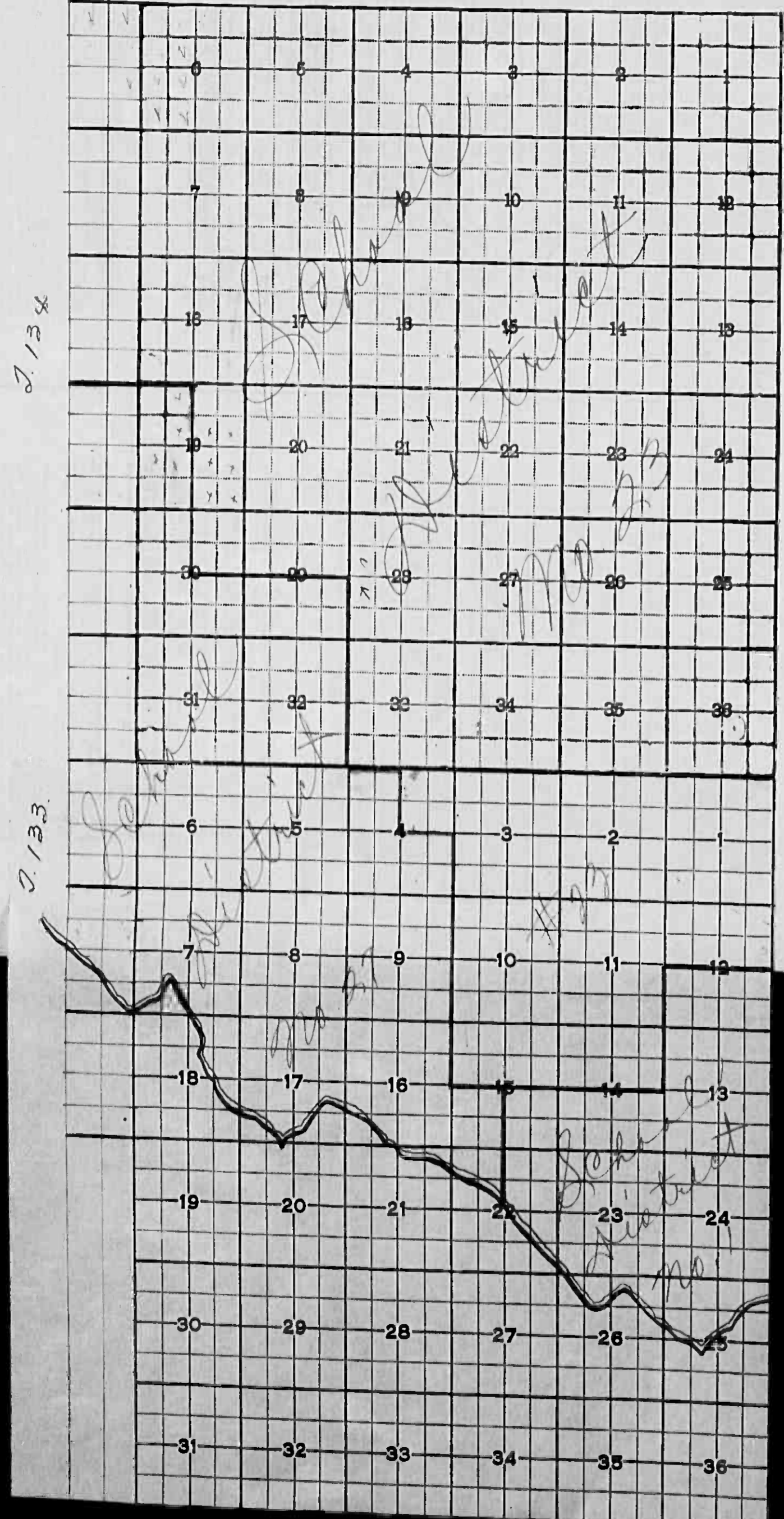
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For Convenience of Auditor in Showing Boundaries of School Districts

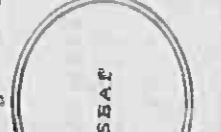
