Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.)

Sec. 1974. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All Real and Personal Property in this State, and all Personal property of persons residing therein, . . . is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED. Sec. 1984. . . . Personal Property shall be listed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if acquired on that day, shall be listed by or for the person acquiring it, in the manner following:

- 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this State, shall list the real and personal property of himself, of his wife, of his children, of his stock of joint stock or other companies or corporations, when the property is situated in the county, town, or district where the real and other personal property is situated, . . .

Sec. 2014. Estates of decedents. The personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed at the place of his abode at the time of his death, . . .

Sec. 2015. Personal property of a partner or agent. The property of a partner or agent, . . .

Sec. 2016. Assignments and receivers. Personal property of a minor under guardianship shall be listed and assessed at the place of his abode, . . .

Sec. 2017. Property moved between May and July. The owner of a motor vehicle, . . .

Sec. 2018. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the county, town, or district where the property shall be listed, . . .

Sec. 2002. Lists to be Verified. Every person required to list property for taxation shall make out and deliver to the assessor upon blank furnished by him, a verified statement of all personal property of himself, of his wife, . . .

Sec. 2003. Failure to obtain list. In case of failure to obtain a list, fair and complete, list thereof, . . .

Sec. 2004. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who in making any statement, oral or written, . . .

Sec. 2005. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall require any person to furnish a list, . . .

Sec. 2006. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who in making any statement, oral or written, . . .

Sec. 2007. Assessment of Property. All real and personal property subject to a general property tax and not subject to any other taxation shall be assessed as follows:

- Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined shall constitute a class for valuation purposes, . . .

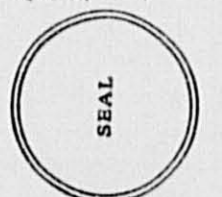
