Sec. 1984. All real property subject to taxation shall be listed and assessed every even-numbered year with reference to its value on May 1 preceding the assessment...

Sec. 1989. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following: Every person of full age and sound mind...

Sec. 2002-1. Household Goods. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel...

Sec. 2012-1. Personal property of electric light and power companies outside of cities and villages. Personal property of electric light and power companies...

Sec. 2018. Where listed in case of doubt. In case of doubt as to the proper place for listing and assessing property or where it cannot be determined in either case...

Sec. 2020. Examination under oath. Whenever the assessor shall be of the opinion that the person listing property for himself or for any other person, company, or corporation...

Sec. 10904. False statement regarding taxes. Every person who, in making any statement, oral or written, who shall wilfully make any statement as to any material matter which he knows to be false...

Class 1. Iron ore whether mined or unmined, shall constitute class one (1) and shall be assessed on May 1 of the current year. He shall also make return of its true and full value...

Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including clocks, musical instruments, sewing machines, wearing apparel of members of the family...

Class 3. Live stock, poultry, all agricultural products except as provided by classes three "a," (3a) and manufactured articles, all tools, implements...

Class 4. All property not included in the three preceding classes shall constitute class four (4) and shall be valued and assessed at forty (40) per cent of the full and true value thereof.
