EXTRACTS FROM LAWS

(Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minn. Statutes 1927.)

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 1874. Property subject to taxation—All real and personal property in the state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, 1914. is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

RELATING TO THE LISTING OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

Sec. 1884. All real property subject to taxation shall be listed and assessed every even-numbered year with reference to its value on May 1 preceding the year of assessment, and all real property becoming taxable during the year shall be listed and assessed on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1885. Personal property

Sec. 1885. Personal property of full age and sound mind shall be listed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a resident of this state, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1886. Personal property of non-resident

Sec. 1886. Personal property of non-resident shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a non-resident of this state, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1887. Personal property of decedent

Sec. 1887. Personal property of a decedent shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a decedent, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1888. Personal property of guardian

Sec. 1888. Personal property of a guardian shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a guardian, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1889. Personal property of trustee

Sec. 1889. Personal property of a trustee shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a trustee, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1890. Personal property of partner

Sec. 1890. Personal property of a partner shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a partner, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1891. Personal property of assignee

Sec. 1891. Personal property of an assignee shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is an assignee, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1892. Personal property of receiver

Sec. 1892. Personal property of a receiver shall be listed and assessed in the manner following: stock of any person or corporation, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, bonds, shares of stock, money loaned or invested in any person or corporation, and other personal property, when the owner thereof is a receiver, shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to its value on May 1, and, if required on that day, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1893. Personal property of executor
