(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1945)

Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 273.00.

Sec. 273.01. Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to the first day of May in any year, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by the person acquiring it.

Sec. 273.02. Personal property shall be listed in the hands of the owner, or in the hands of a partner or agent thereof, or in the hands of a body politic or corporate, by the proper agent thereof.

Sec. 273.03. Personal property of non-resident owners shall be listed and assessed annually with reference to the first day of May in any year, and if acquired on that day, shall be listed by the person acquiring it.

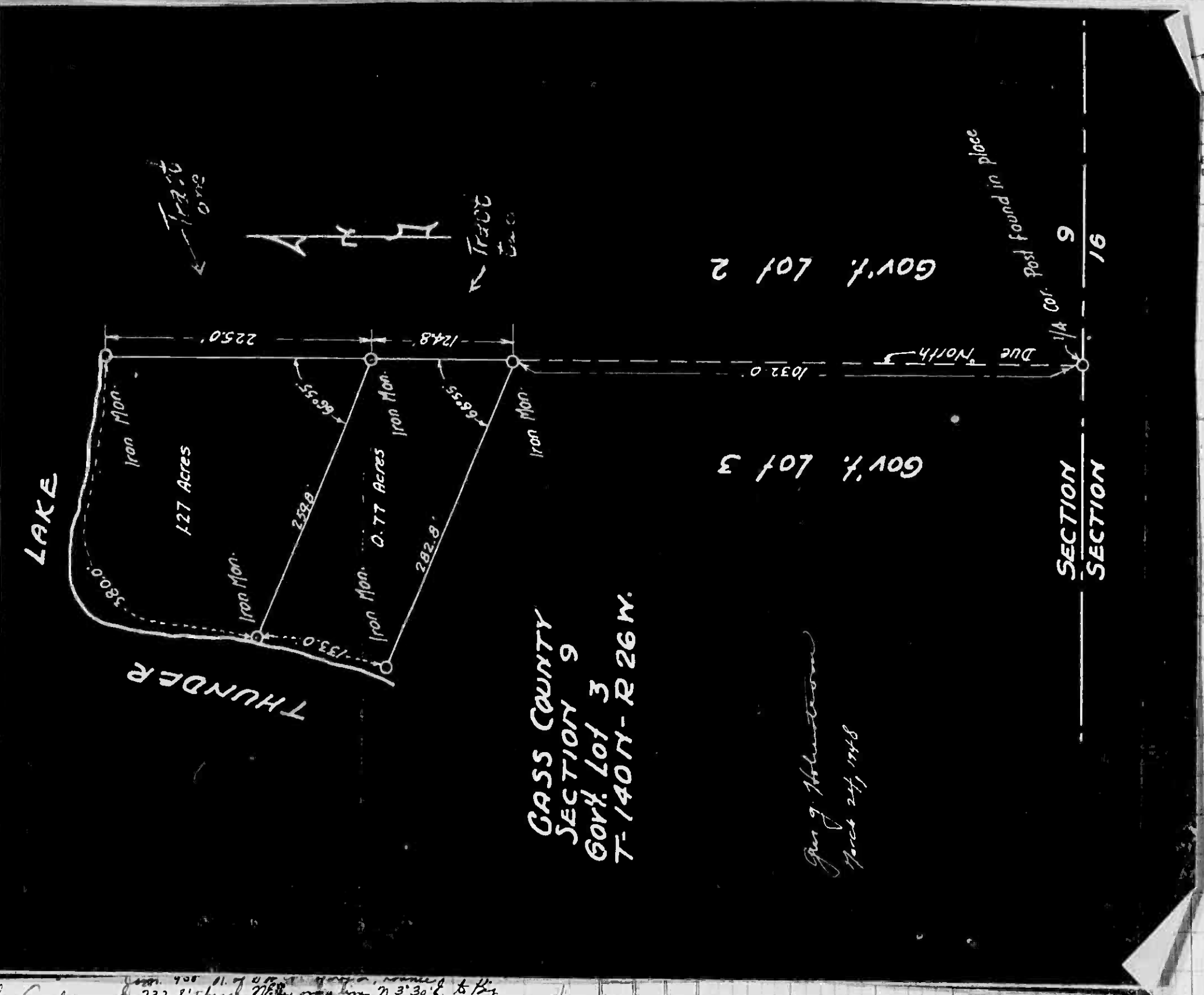
