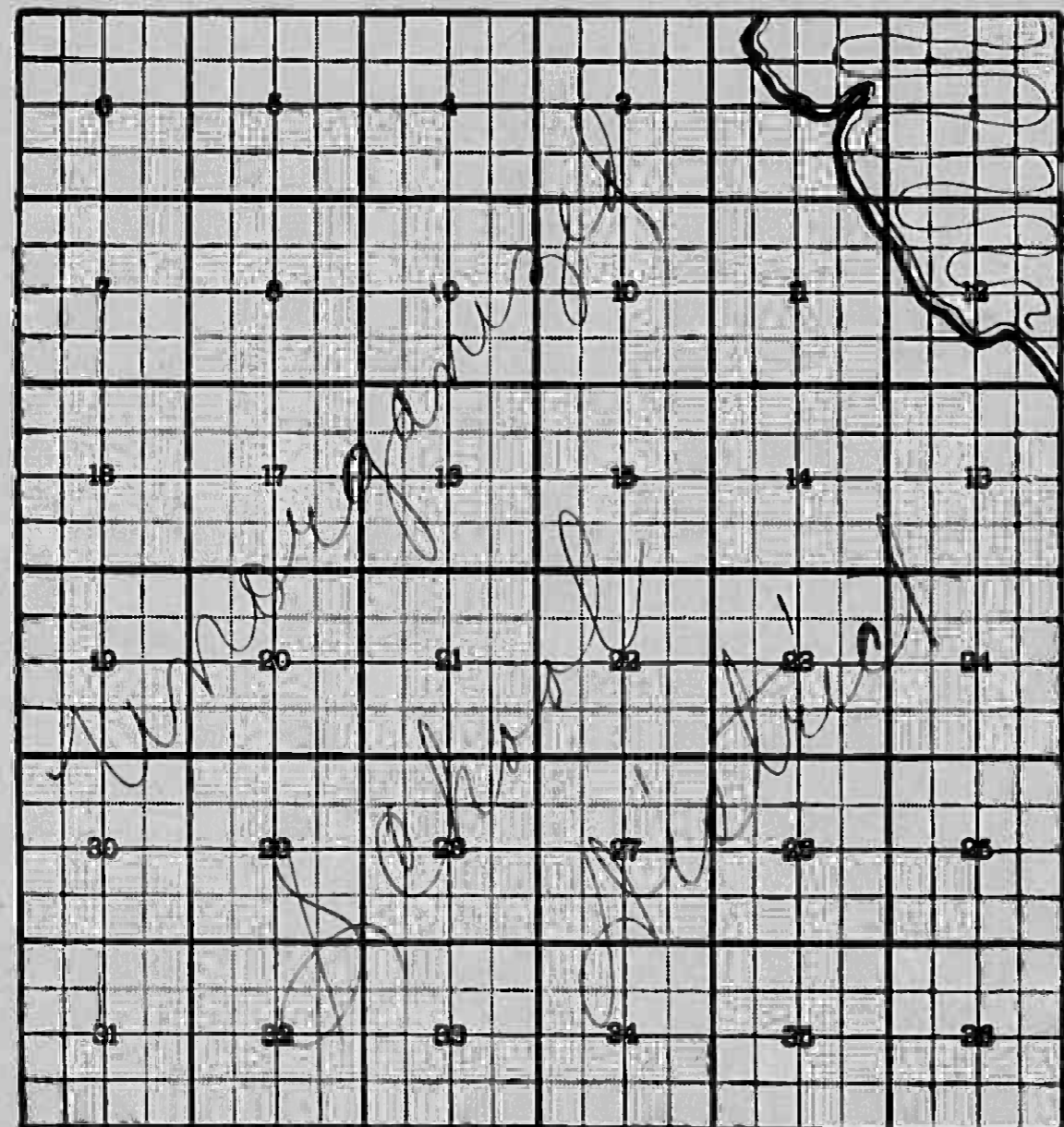

Extracts from Laws, Relating to the Listing of Personal Property. (Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1937)

Sec. 1074. Property subject to taxes. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 1081. Personal property to be listed. Personal property shall be listed in the manner following:

1. Every person who owns, or has an interest in, any real estate, or any stock or other securities, or any other personal property, or any interest therein, shall list the same in the manner and at the time prescribed in this chapter.
2. The assessor shall also list, in the name of the principal, all real estate, or any stock or other securities, or any other personal property, or any interest therein, which is owned, or has an interest in, by a partner or agent thereof, or by a corporation, or by the partnership, or by the trustee, or by the guardian, or by the person having such property in charge.
3. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust for the purpose of the payment of a debt, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor, shall be listed in the name of the person for whose benefit it is held.
4. The property of a partnership shall be listed in the name of the partnership.
5. The property of a corporation shall be listed in the name of the corporation.
6. The property of a firm or company, by a partner or agent thereof.
7. The property of a partnership shall be listed in the name of the partnership.
8. The property of a corporation shall be listed in the name of the corporation.

Sec. 1082. Real estate to be listed. Real estate shall be listed in the name of the owner, or in the name of the person for whose benefit it is held in trust for the purpose of the payment of a debt, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor, or in the name of the partnership, or in the name of the corporation, or in the name of the firm or company, or in the name of the partner or agent thereof, or in the name of the person having such property in charge.

Sec. 1083. Personal property to be listed. Personal property shall be listed in the name of the owner, or in the name of the person for whose benefit it is held in trust for the purpose of the payment of a debt, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor, or in the name of the partnership, or in the name of the corporation, or in the name of the firm or company, or in the name of the partner or agent thereof, or in the name of the person having such property in charge.

Sec. 1084. Exemption of certain property. Personal property of the following kinds shall be exempt from taxation:

1. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust for the purpose of the payment of a debt, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor.
2. The property of a partnership, or of a corporation, or of a firm or company, or of a partner or agent thereof, or of a person having such property in charge, which is used for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor.
3. The property of a person for whose benefit it is held in trust for the purpose of the payment of a debt, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor, which is used for the purpose of the maintenance of a child, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a widow, or for the purpose of the maintenance of a minor.
