OFFICE OF COUNTY AUDITOR, APR 15 1917

County, CASS Assessor of the Town of Turtle Lake according to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Assessment Books for the said town for the year 1917.

containing a list of all Real Estate that has become subject to taxation since the Assessment of May 1, 1916, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source, and I hereby direct you to assess all Personal Property, and to make such changes in Real Estate as are required in the odd-numbered year, and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.

A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book. County Auditor.

Extracts from Laws Relating to the Listing of Personal Property.

(Section Numbers Refer to Minnesota Statutes 1915)

Sec. 273.01. * * * PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION. All real and personal property in this state, and all personal property of persons residing therein, * * * is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 273.01. * * * Personal property shall be listed and assessed annually with regard to the following: 1. May 1 and if acquired after that date, shall be listed by or for the persons acquiring it.

Sec. 273.22. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the following cases: 1. Every person of full age and sound mind, being a resident of this state, shall list all of his * * * personal property.

Sec. 273.27. Certain personal property. The following personal property shall be listed: 1. The property of a minor, child or insane person shall be listed by his guardian, or by the person having such property in his right, or by the executor or administrator.

Sec. 273.29. Merchants and manufacturers. The personal property of a merchant or manufacturer shall be listed in the town or district where he carries on * * *

Sec. 273.30. Farm property of non-resident. When the owner of a farm in this state is a non-resident, the farm shall be listed and assessed in the town or district where the farm is situated. If the farm is situated in several townships or districts, it shall be listed and assessed in some one district in which the principal place of business of such farm is located.

Sec. 273.32. Elevators, etc., on railroad. All elevators and warehouses, with the machinery which are not in good faith owned and operated and exclusively controlled by such company, shall be listed and assessed as personal property in the town or district where situated.

Sec. 273.33. Pipeline companies. Personal property of * * * pipeline companies engaged in the business of transporting natural gas, gasoline, or other petroleum products, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 273.34. Manufacturers. Every manufacturer required to list his property shall also list the value of the property pertaining to his business, including the value of the following: 1. The value of any property owned to him from any other place for the sale of such property, and which he does not intend to use in his business.

Sec. 273.36. Assignees and receivers. Personal property in the hands of an assignee or receiver shall be listed and assessed at the place of living before his appointment.

Sec. 273.37. Property moved between May and July. The owner of personal property removed from one county, town, or district to another, shall be listed and assessed in the county, town, or district where the same is usually kept.

Sec. 272.42. Where listed in case of debt. In case of doubt as to where the property shall be listed, it shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 272.43. Classification of property. Subdivision 1. Movables shall be classified for purposes of taxation as provided in this section.

Subdivision 2. Class 1. Iron ore, when mined and conveyed at fifty feet or more from the surface of the ground, shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 3. Class 2. All household goods and furniture, including the contents of a dwelling, shall be assessed as personal property.

Subdivision 4. Class 3. All agricultural products, except as provided in this section, shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 5. Class 4. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as personal property.

Subdivision 6. Class 5. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 7. Class 6. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 8. Class 7. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 9. Class 8. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 10. Class 9. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 11. Class 10. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 12. Class 11. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 13. Class 12. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 14. Class 13. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 15. Class 14. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Subdivision 16. Class 15. All property not included in the preceding classes shall be assessed as real property.

Section 273.03. Minnesota Statutes 1915. Assessment; Mode. The county auditor shall annually provide the necessary assessment books and blanks at the expense of the county, for and to correspond with each assessment district. He shall make out, in the real property assessment book, complete lists of all lands or lots subject to taxation, showing the names of the owners, if to him known, and, if unknown so stated opposite each tract or lot, the number of acres, and the lots or parts of lots or blocks, included in each description of property. * * *

The assessors shall meet at the office of the county auditor on a day to be fixed by the Commissioner of Taxation for the purpose of receiving instructions as to their duties under the laws of the state. * * *

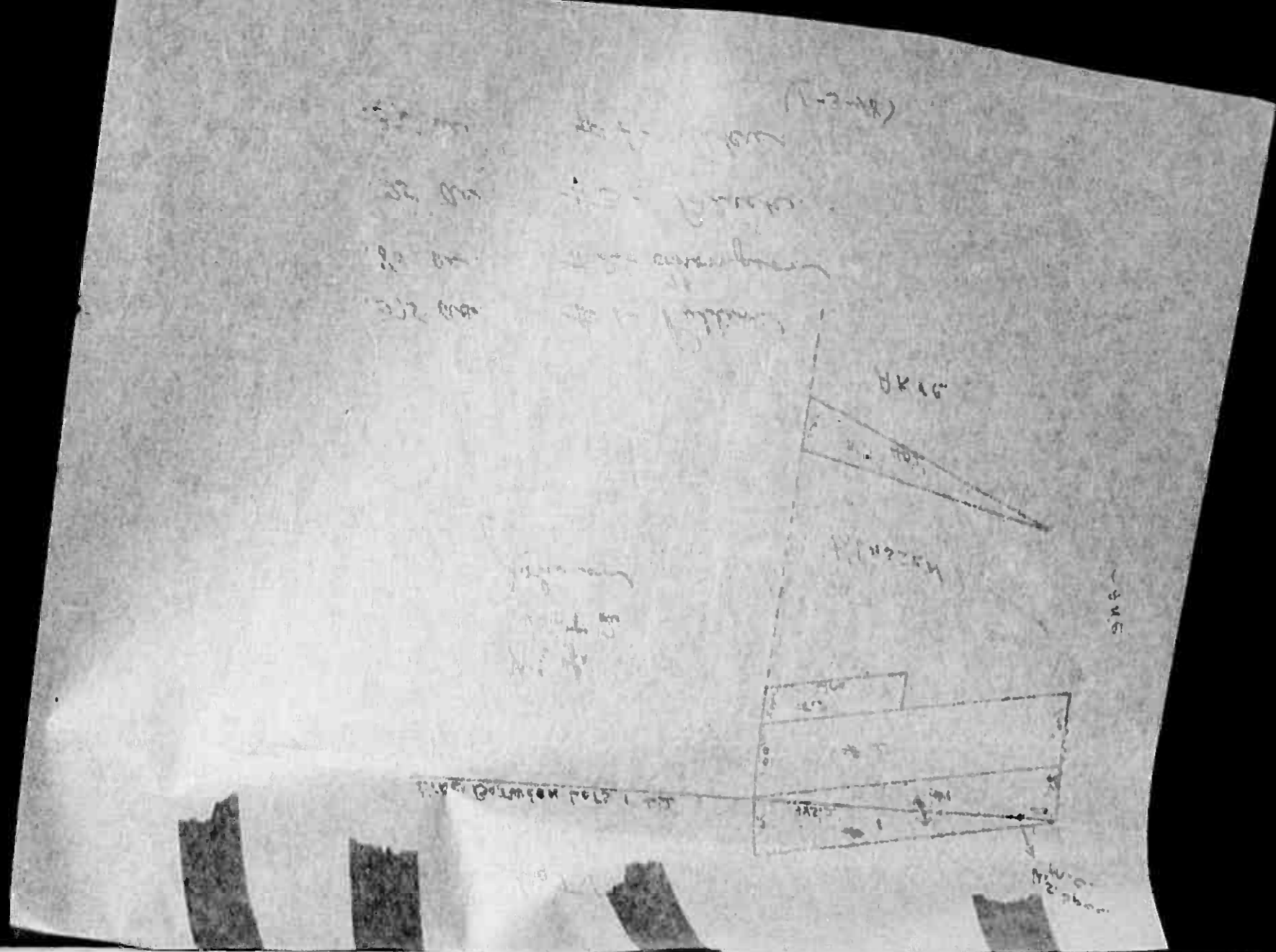
