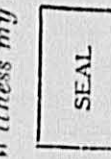

H.A. Maxwell County, Minn., 1937
Assessor of the County of Cass, Minn.
 According to the requirements of law, I herewith deliver to you the Real and Personal Property Assessment Books of the year 1937, containing a list of all Platted and Unplatted Real Estate subject to taxation, so far as the same have come to my knowledge from any source and I hereby direct you to assess all property and make return thereof to me as required by the law prescribing your duties hereto annexed.
 A form of the return to be signed by you is appended in this book.

Extracts from Laws, Relating to the Listing of Personal Property. (Section Numbers refer to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927)

Sec. 1921. Property subject to taxation in this state, and such as is by law exempt from taxation, is taxable, except such as is by law exempt from taxation.

WHEN LISTED AND ASSESSED

Sec. 1904. Personal property shall be listed and assessed as follows: 1. Personal property owned or controlled by the owner, agent, or trustee resident in the county, town, or district where the property is situated, shall be listed by or for the person owning it.

Sec. 1905. By whom listed. Personal property shall be listed in the name of the person owning it, or of his agent, or of the trustee, or of the executor or administrator of the estate of a deceased person. If the property is owned by a partnership, it shall be listed in the name of the partnership.

Sec. 1906. Where listed. Personal property shall be listed in the county, town, or district where the property is situated.

Sec. 1907. Contents of list. The list shall contain a description of the property, its value, and the name of the owner, agent, or trustee. It shall also contain a statement of the property, its value, and the name of the owner, agent, or trustee.

Sec. 1908. Return of list. The list shall be returned to the assessor on or before the first Monday in January following the assessment year.

Sec. 1909. Inspection of list. The assessor may inspect the list at any time during the assessment year.

Sec. 1910. Correction of list. The assessor may correct the list at any time during the assessment year.

Sec. 1911. Penalties. Any person who fails to list property or who lists property falsely shall be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars and not more than ten dollars.

Sec. 2012. Where listed in case of debt. In case of debt as to the personal property of a decedent, the assessor shall list such property as is in the name of the decedent at the time of his death, and such property as is in the name of the decedent at the time of his death, and such property as is in the name of the decedent at the time of his death.
