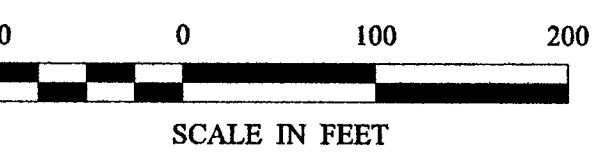
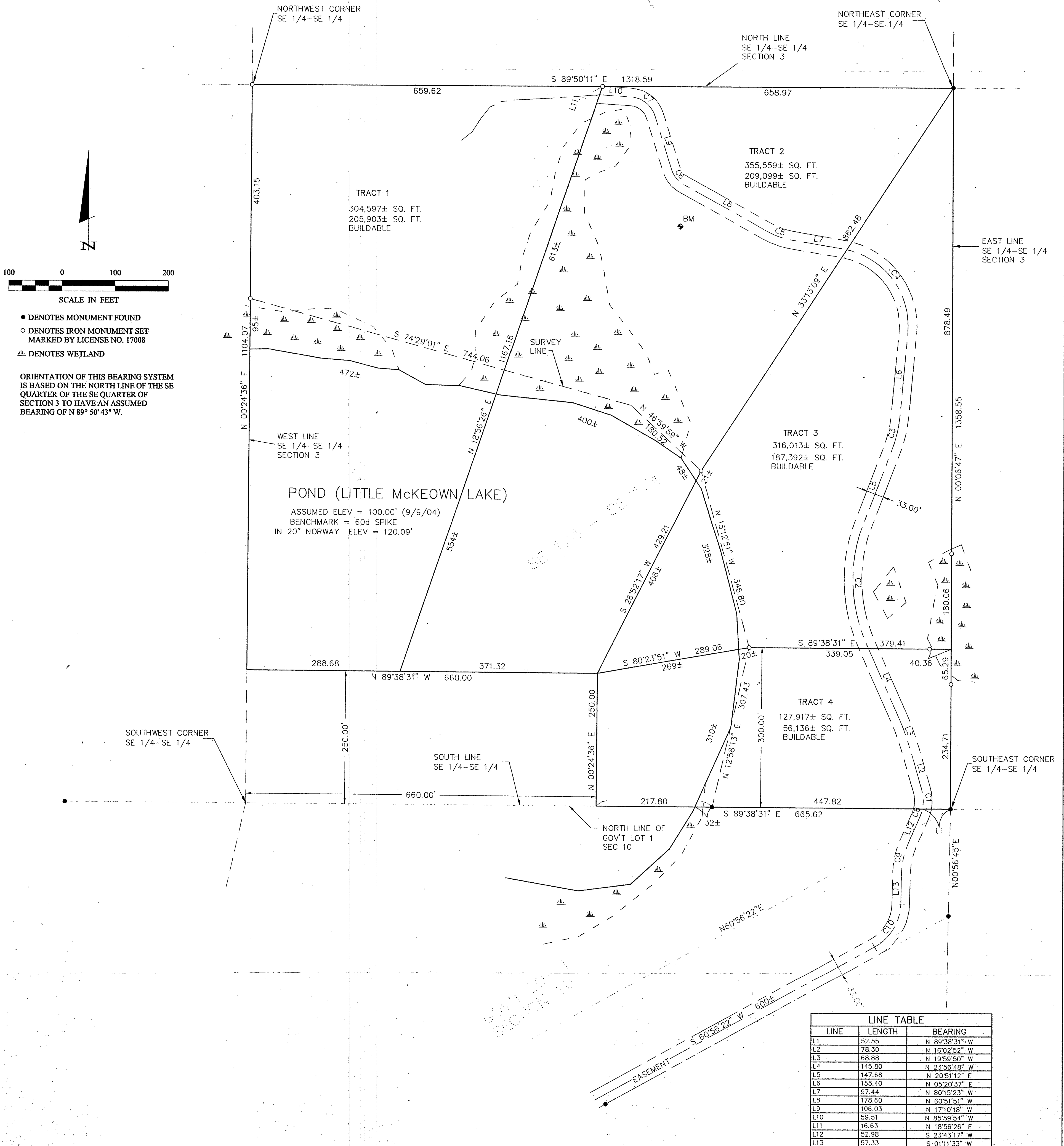


CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY
