
Surveyor's Notes

The plat of SYLVAN SHADY SHORES, surveyed in 1941 by Gus G. Holmstrom and of record, shows monuments placed only at survey lines which run across lot lines. The plat does not purport to monument the individual lot corners. The plat does not provide the necessary math to compute the locations of many of the lot corners, specifically along the right-of-way of 'Shady Lane', now known as 26th Avenue SW. The plat provides distances from the Sylvan Lake shoreline to the right-of-way. These distances cannot be reliably used in the establishment of the right-of-way. For purposes of this survey, the physical centerline of the existing road, which appears to be in continuous use since the original platting, has been used as the center of the 25 foot width of the right-of-way. A width of 12.50 feet on either side of this centerline has been applied in the determination of the lot lines along the right-of-way.

Lot line locations lying north of Lot 12 in the subject plat have been determined by this survey in reconstructing the intent of the record plat using the re-established survey lines of said plat. Lot lines were then extended to said right-of-way as determined above.
