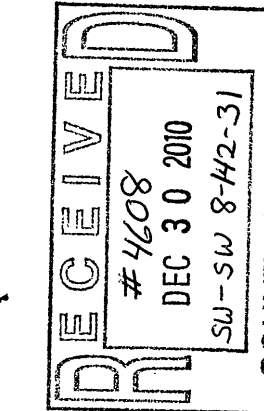

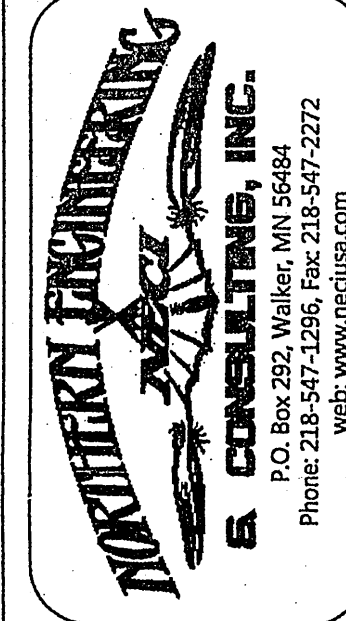

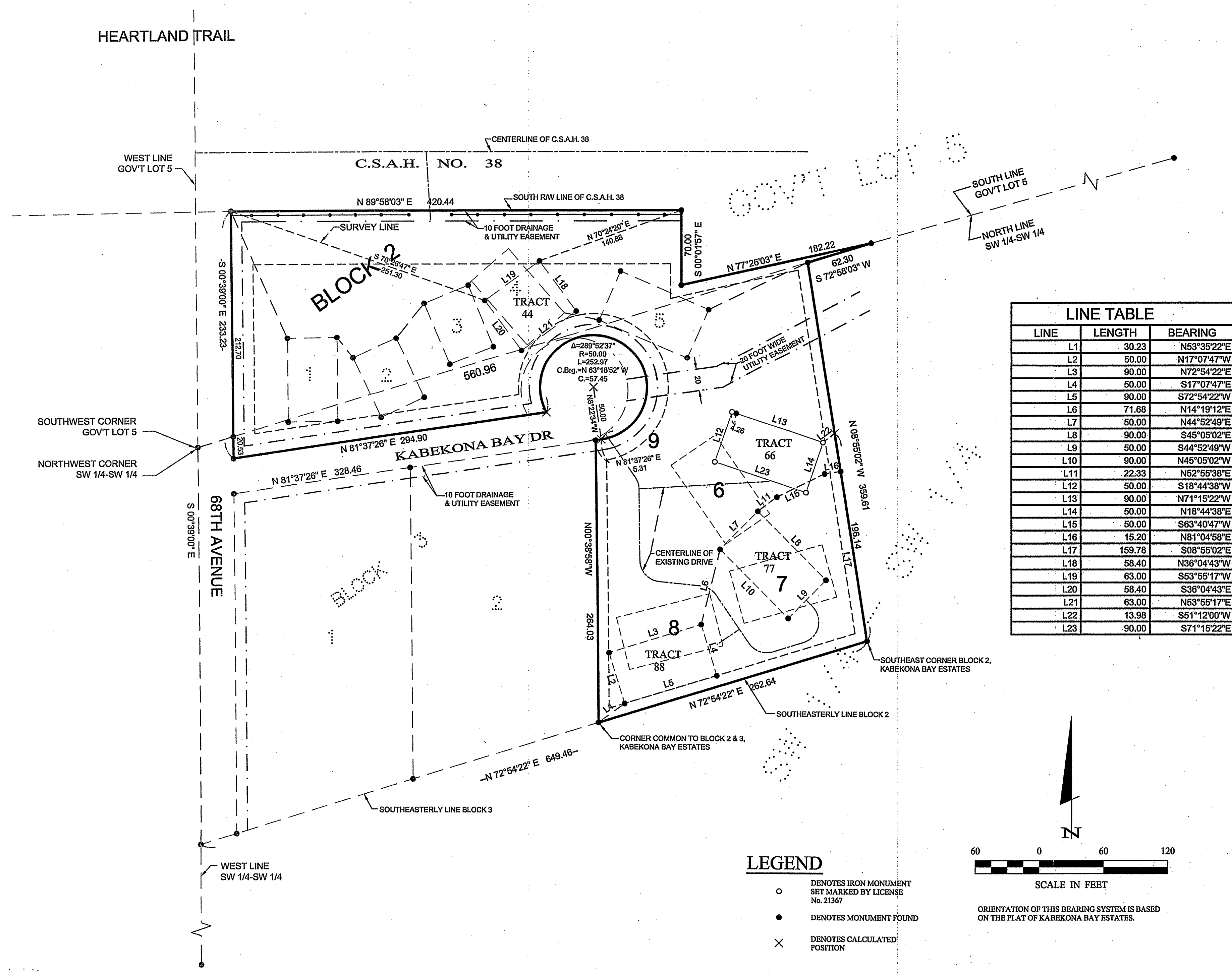

TRACT 66

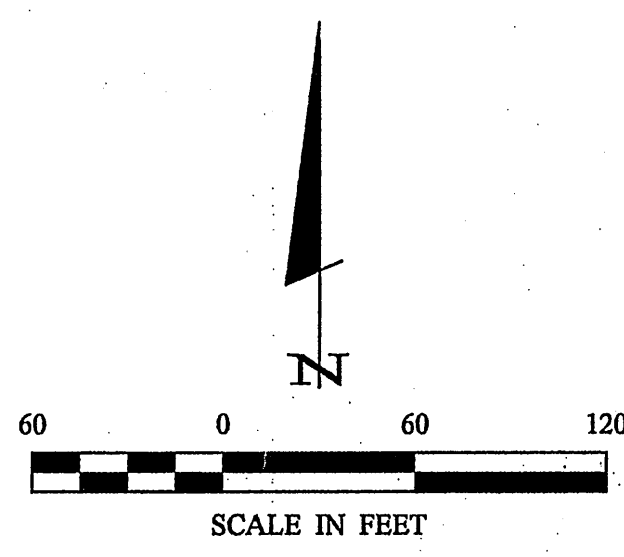
That part of Lot 6 and Lot 9, Block 2, KABEKONA BAY ESTATES, according to the recorded plat thereof, Cass County, Minnesota, described as follows: COMMENCING at the Southeast Corner, said Block 2; thence North 08 degrees 55 minutes 02 seconds West, assigned bearing, along the east line of said Block 2, for a distance of 196.14 feet; thence South 51 degrees 12 minutes 00 seconds West 13.98 feet to the point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence North 71 degrees 15 minutes 22 seconds West 90.00 feet; thence South 18 degrees 44 minutes 38 seconds West 50.00 feet; thence South 71 degrees 15 minutes 22 seconds East 90.00 feet; thence North 18 degrees 44 minutes 38 seconds East 50.00 feet to the point of beginning.
