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Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner of Section 14, Township 133 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The original land survey was run in 1870 by Mr. William P. Allen and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1911 Mr. Harold Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a 3" iron pipe at this location from Mr. Allen's bearing trees.

In 1915 Mr. P. R. Boese, for Mr. Curo, used the iron pipe for work in Section 13.'

In 1942 Mr. John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, made ties to four trees around this corner location.

In 1977 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the 3" iron pipe and two of Mr. Curo's bearing trees.
