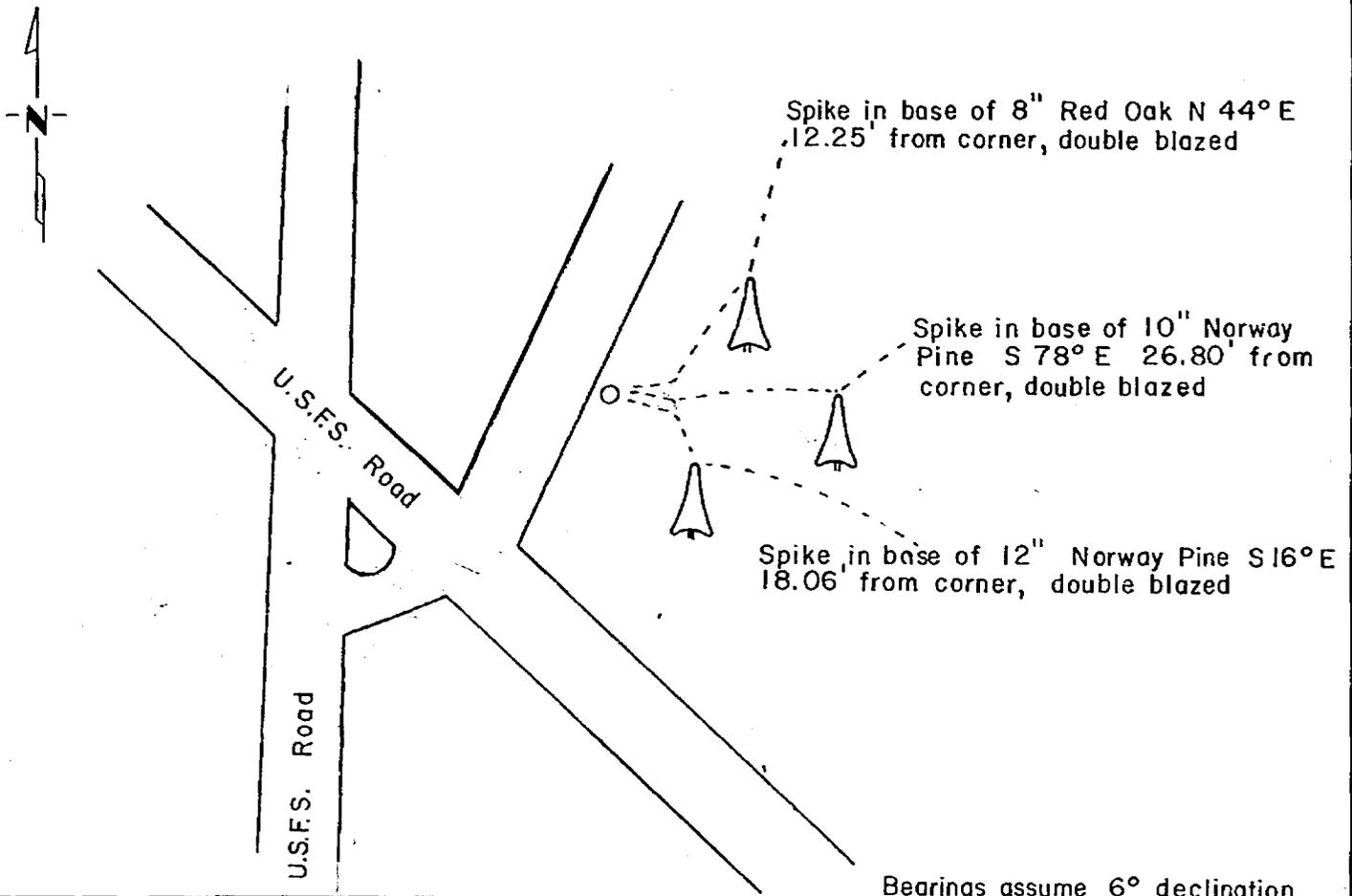

Statement of Evidence:

- 1874 - P.F. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, subdivided the Township. He set a post to mark the corner and four bearing trees as accessories; a Yellow Pine 24 inch, North 80 degrees West, 200 links, a Yellow Pine 24 inch, South 32 degrees West, 80 links, a Black Pine 8 inch, North 26 degrees East, 19 links, and a Black Pine 6 inch, North 57 degrees East, 45 links.
- 1914 - J.A. Doney, forest ranger, found a Norway Pine bearing tree on the North side of road. Corner was 20 paces North.
- 1981 - David D. Claypool Land Surveying, subdivided section 24 for Bug School site. A large pine was found down and decayed, but quite evident, on the North side of old road. A large pine stump was bulldozed out and pushed to the North side of the road. The large pine was determined to be an original bearing tree. The corner was set North 32 degrees East 52.80 feet from the bearing tree. The corner fall 60 feet North of the road and fits very well with proportionate measurement in every direction.
