Statement of Evidence:

- 1874 P.F. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, subdivided the Township. He set a post to mark the corner and two bearing trees as accessories; a Cedar 5 inch South 28 degrees West 28 links and a Tamarack 6 inch North 38 degrees East 28 links.
- 1914 J.A. Doney, Forest Ranger, found two bearing trees, a Tamarack 14 inch in section 24 and a Cedar 8 inch in section 25.
- 1974 Charles E Akin Jr, U.S. Cadatral Surveyor, BLM, subdivided section 25. He found no evidence of the original corner and computed lost position. He did not monument this corner.
- 1981 David D. Claypool Land Surveying, subdivided section 24. No evidence of the corner was found and it was set by lost methods according to computations of the BIM survey of 1974.
