

Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner.
- 1970 USFS technician L. Witthoeft found the GLO brass cap monument in place.
- 1980 USFS technician W. Olson again found the marked GLO brass cap monument in place up 4". A rough measurement was made south to the Center  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 15 and checked good with the GLO distance. An angle was turned from this corner sighting south to the Center  $\frac{1}{4}$  to the SMC to the west. The angle agreed well with the difference in the GLO bearings. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- 1981 On Dec. 8, I visited corner and found items as per 1980 USFS report. Analysis of the 1980 USFS report indicates that the monument is in the same location as set in 1918.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
