

Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 16" N. Pine N 51-15 E 204 links and 16" N. Pine S 52-15 W 73 links.
- 1970 USFS technician L. Witthoef found the GLO brass cap monument in place and one bearing tree alive and the stump of the other one.
- 1980 USFS technician W. Olson found the GLO brass cap monument in place up 6" and in good condition. The NE bearing tree was found alive with the blaze grown over. Two new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 4.0' west and east of the corner.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1981 On Dec. 22, I visited the corner and found items as per the 1980 USFS report. The pine stump as noted in the 1970 USFS report was found, but found no evidence of blaze or scribing. Accepted found monument as being in the same position as when set in 1918.
