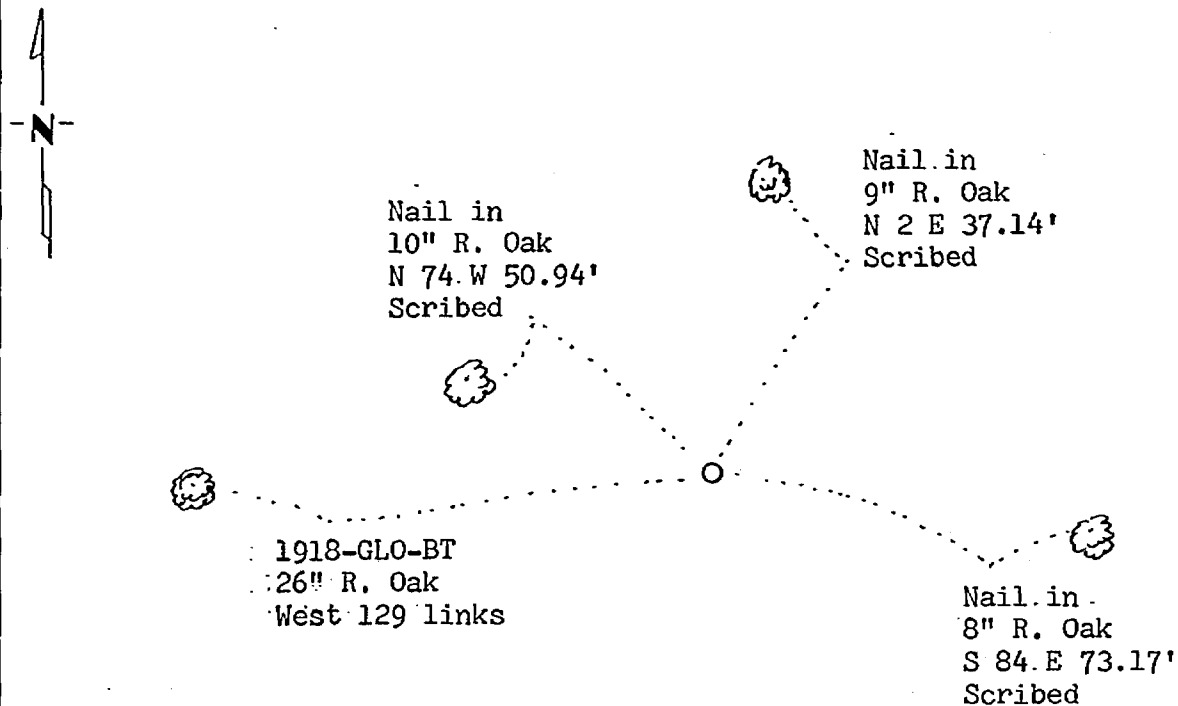

Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 12" Oak West 129 links and 8" Maple N 21 W 250 links.
- 1980 USFS technician Gary Brama found the GLO brass cap monument in place up 4" in good condition. The Oak bearing tree was found alive. No evidence was found of the Maple. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. A steel sign post was set 2.5' east of the corner.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1981 On Dec. 22, I visited the corner and found items as per the 1980 USFS report. The 1918 Oak BT had visible scar. I accepted the found monument as marking the same position as when originally set in 1918.
