

Statement of Evidence:

- 1873 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Birch West 10 links and 6" Birch S 10 E 12 links.
- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey reestablished this corner by proportional lost method. No evidence of the original post or bearing trees was found. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 6" Poplar S 64 W 118 links and 12" Black Oak N 42° W 89 links.
- 1980 USFS technician William Olson found the brass cap monument in place in good condition and the 25' stub of the 1918 Black Oak bearing tree N 42° W 89 links with the scribing grown over. 3 new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts set 4' east and south.
- 1981 On Dec. 8, I visited corner area and found items as per 1980 USFS report.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
