


Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner.
- 1980 USFS technician W. Olson found the GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 0.5'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Line was run south from the South 1/16 corner of Sections 22 & 23 to the Southeast corner of Sec. 22 and rough measurement made. This corner was found to be within a foot of ~~the~~ and within a foot of straight line. Steel sign posts were set 4.0' north and 4.0' south of the corner.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Visited this corner on Jan. 29 and found items as per 1980 USFS report. Accepted the found monument as being in the same position as when set in 1918. The 1980 report also shows a 1½ iron pipe was found 18.3' easterly of the brass cap. I do not have any idea of who set this or what it is supposed to represent.
