In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, US Surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap for the $E\frac{1}{4}$, Sec.1 from which he marked the following bearing trees. A 12" pine N 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 72.6' and a 6" oak S $60\frac{1}{2}$ W 44.22 feet.

On September 11, 1981, Walter E. Curo found the 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap stamped $E_{\frac{1}{2}}$, S1-S6 from which we find a 14" pine snag with an old rusty tag nailed on it which stands N 12 - 20 E 72.6 feet. We check S $60\frac{1}{2}$ W 44.2 feet, but all we find is a hole from a rotted out tree. We make new bearing trees as shown on the front of this card.
