In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, a US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the NE 1/16 corner from which he made the following BT's. A 8" jackpine N 50½ W 249 LKS and a 6" white pak S 31 W 228 LKS.

On October 8, 1981, Walter Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument standing in good condition. The 6" white oak BT is now a 14" tree hollow, but still living. The 8" jackpine is now a 20" snag. Both check good for bearing and distance. We make new BT's as shown on front.
