



In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, a US Surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for S 1/64 corner on west side of Sec. 2. No BT's were made.

On September 24, 1981, Walter E. Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument on the fence line from which we made BT's as shown on front.
