

In 1917, Earl G. Harrington US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for AP 3 TR 1264 and AP 2 TR 1273 and AP 1 TR 1279 and AP 4 TR 1629. No BT's were made.

On October 26, 1981, Walter E. Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument standing in good condition on a small island in a bog from which we make BT's as shown on front.
