

In 1918 Albinnus N. Kimmell US Cadastral Engineer set a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap for AP 4 for TR 1657 and AP 1 for TR 1653. No bearing trees were marked.

On September 9, 1981, Walter E. Curo found the iron pipe monument standing as set from which bearing trees were marked as shown on the front of this card.
