

In 1918, Albinus N. Kimmell, US Cadastral Engineer set a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap for AP 1 TR 1277 and AP 2 TR 1480 and AP 3 TR 1648. No bearing trees were marked.

On September 10, 1981, Walter E. Curo found the iron pipe monument standing as set from which bearing trees were marked as shown on the front of this card.
