

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 6, Township 138 North,  
Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1865, during the Original Public Land Survey, a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1919 Mr. Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a 8" x 8" concrete post at this corner.

In 1981 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the concrete monument.
