## Statement of Evidence:

In 1918, Earl G. Harrington, a US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the corner to sections 3-4-9 and 10 from which he marked the following Bt's. A 6" poplar N-45E 113Lks., A 18" WO S  $66\frac{1}{2}$ W 61 Lks., A 14" poplar N 73 W 109 Lks, all of which were obliberated by the construction of the highway.

On 6-3-1982, Walter E. Curo found a 6" spike  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet below the surface of the black top. The distance from this spike to the  $S\frac{1}{4}$  decorner is .44 of a foot longer then G.L.O. distance and the distance from this spike to the  $E\frac{1}{4}$  corner is .56 of a foot shorter than G.L.O. I replaced the spike with a 2"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap.
