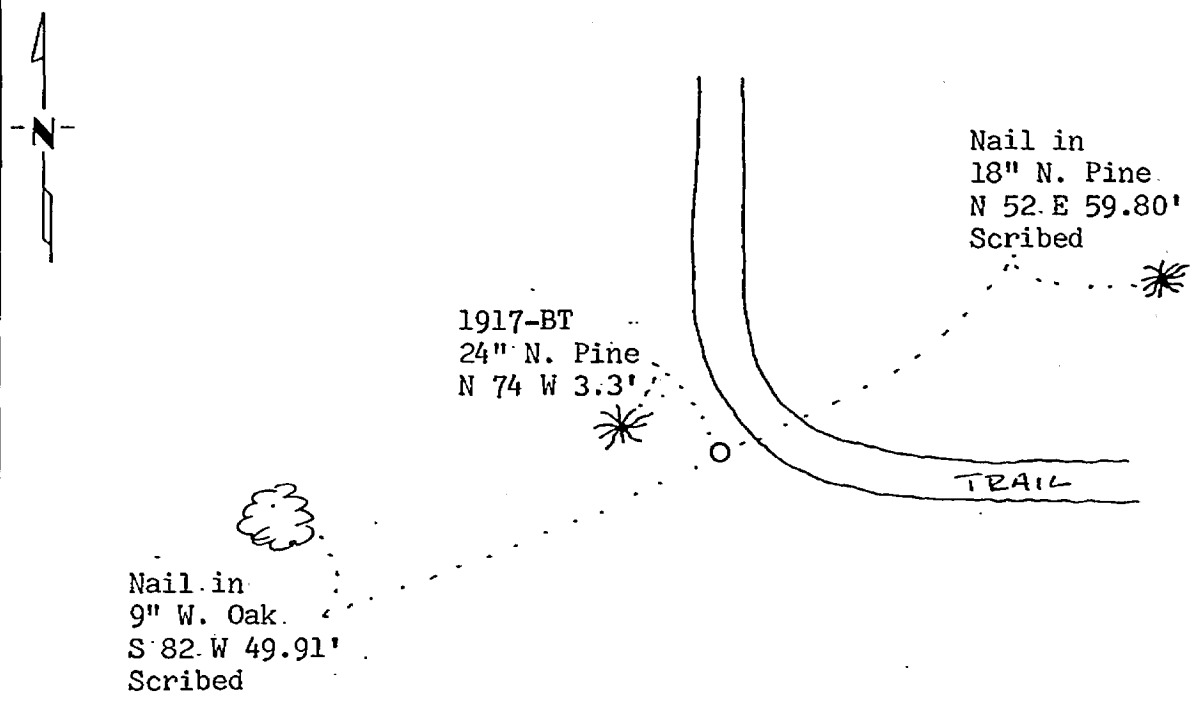

Statement of Evidence:

- 1917 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 7" N. Pine N 74 W 5 links and 5" N. Pine N 60 E 5 links.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician W. Olsen found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 0.4'. The following bearing trees were found: 24" N. Pine N 74 W 3.3' with overgrown scar facing the corner. Two new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 4.0' north and 4.0' east of the corner.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 On Sept. 9 I visited the corner and found items as per the 1981 USFS reports. I accepted the monument as marking the same position as when set in 1917 based on the one bearing tree found.
