

Statement of Evidence:

- 1926 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 5" Poplar S 86 E 42 links and 16" Poplar N 4 W 21 links.
- 1970 U.S. Forest Service technician S. Morrison found brass cap monument in good condition. Both Poplar bearing trees were found down and badly rotted at record bearing and distance. A location tag was placed on a 3" Oak 6' north of the monument.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 12". No remains were found of the Poplar bearing trees. Tag placed in 1970 was still in place. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 2.9' east and 2.55' south of the corner.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1926 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
