

Statement of Evidence:

- 1930 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 8" Birch N 48 E 80 links and 6" Birch N 81 W 11 links.
- 1934 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: CCC record shows brass cap monument found and one bearing tree 6" Birch N 83 W 11½ links.
- 1968 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: L. Martinson found the brass cap monument and one bearing tree 11" Birch N 81 W 11 links.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 4". The following bearing trees were found: Birch stump (recently cut) N 81 W 7.3' with some scribe visible. No evidence found of other Birch. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 2.65' north and 2.85' east of the corner.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 On Sept. 7 I visited the corner and found items as per the 1981 USFS reports. I accepted the monument as marking the same position as when set in 1930 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
