

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 140 North,
Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1923 Mr. John Greene, County Surveyor, found a 2" capped pipe at the corner location. This is the same type of monument Mr. John Curo, County Surveyor, used for corners between 1907 and 1913.

In 1982 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the 2" capped pipe and accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
