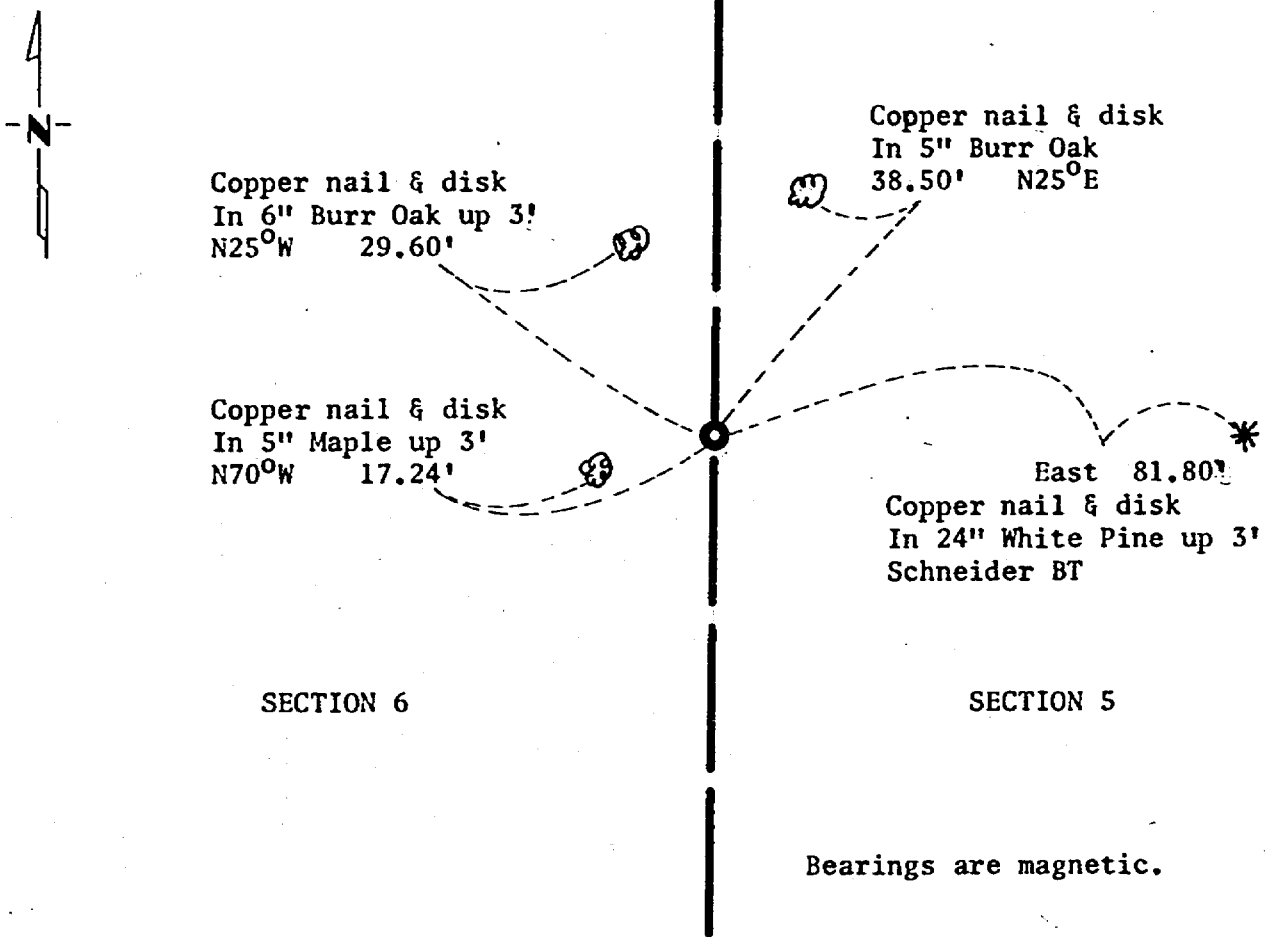

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 6, Township 140 North,
Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1923 Mr. John Greene, County Surveyor, set a 2" capped pipe at a lost porportion position.

In 1966 Mr. R. Schneider found the 2" capped pipe and made two bearing tree ties.

In 1982 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the 2" capped pipe and one of Mr. Schneider's bearing trees, and accept this as the correct location for the corner.
