

Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner Section 7, Township 140 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1923, Mr. John Greene found evidence of the original corner and set a 2" capped pipe for the corner.

In 1928, the Minnesota Highway Department found the capped pipe and tied it to the Highway alignment.

In 1965, Mr. Robert Schneider found the capped pipe and made three bearing tree ties.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered one of Mr. Schneiders Bearing trees, but the 2" capped pipe and the other 2 bearing trees were destroyed in a recent road building project. We also recovered the 1/16th corner between the North Quarter Corner and the Northeast corner which Mr. Greene had set. By doubling the 1/16th distance, we fit the bearing tree distance and Mr. Greene's distance across the north line of the section. We accept this position as a perpetuation of the original Government corner.
