Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner of Section 31, Township 140 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1928 the Minnesota State Highway Department found a railroad spike buried in the old road bed.

In 1983 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered a 60D spike in the center of the old road and Government distance from the Southwest Corner of Section 30. The 1928 zailroad spike was not found. We set the corner at a lost location on line and government porportion between the Southwest Corner and Southeast Corner of Section 30. This location is 5 feet north of the centerline of the old road and 14 feet west of a fenceline to the north.
