The original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1907, Mr. John Curo set a 8×8 concrete monument for the corner from the original bearing trees.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the 8×8 concrete monument set by Curo and accepts this as the perpetuation of the original Government Corner.
