Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Section 31, Township 139 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1906, Mr. John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set an $8" \times 8" \times 36"$ concrete monument at the location of an iron pin and stone which had been set from the original bearing trees.

In 1928, the Minnesota Highway Department found the concrete monument and tied it to the highway alignment.

In 1946, an iron pipe was set in the centerline of the highway to mark the corner for the plat of "Zaffke's Addition to Backus".

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation found an $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe (down 0.5') 2.5' south of the highway centerline. By reconstructing the 1928 survey information, we determined that the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe is in the same location as the 1928 concrete monument. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts this pipe as a perpetuation of the original Government corner.
